This collection of autobiographical vignettes -- for which I plead guilty of enhancing with fictitious dialogue in order to craft a story -- provides a literary context for reconstructing the actual events, only segments of which are sequestered in memory. In other words, I am determined that in so doing I am involved as much in explanation as I am in entertaining. I am acutely aware of the fact that in this memoir a greater emphasis has been given to my pre-teen years. This imbalance was provoked by sage counsel to restrict the size of this book. Hence, a number of stories emerging from experiences occurring, and/or endured, throughout my high school and college years -- indeed, a number sufficient for more than another book -- were pulled from the manuscript, but not deleted from my computer.
